The strength of the Central Carolina REALTORS® Association (CCRA) lies on Team Leaders, Assistant Leaders and Team members for carrying out the initiatives set forth by the CCRA Board of Directors, including: education, providing a positive REALTOR® image to the public, legislative efforts, ethical matters, networking and social events. The Association benefits from your talents and leadership, and in return you develop new friends and an appreciation of the REALTOR® organization.

Bylaws: Works to ensure our bylaws are completely clear and free of conflicting interpretations. Reviews and recommends revisions to the Board of Directors.

Community Service: Help with several beneficial activities that have are close to the Association's heart: Harvest Hope, The Deanne Venable Children's Garden Project, Cooperative Ministries, Project H.O.P.E. & Habitat for Humanity! As a volunteer you will help fundraise and change the lives of those less fortunate.

Contract Committee: Responsible for maintaining and reviewing all CCRA Contract forms. Works closely with legal council to ensure all forms are written properly.

Education: Responsible for planning all education programs for the membership. Also insuring that members are familiar with the obligations imposed on real estate brokers and agents by the fair housing laws.

Grievance: Members are appointed by the President. Reviews allegations of ethical violations and controversies between REALTORS® and/or members of the public to determine if a hearing by the Professional Standards Team is warranted. (Limited positions available.)

Legislative: The Legislative Committee is tasked with interviewing potential candidates for office as well as keeping on top of current legislative issues. Committee members are asked to help support the position of CCRA with local elected officials.

Membership: Recruits members from non-member companies and recruits non-member companies for REALTOR® membership.

Professional Standards: Team members are appointed by the President. Team members serve on hearing panels as required to hear matters of alleged unethical conduct by association members or to provide arbitration as requested. **Requires previous Grievance Team experience. (Limited positions available and team members MUST have State Association training - which is February 18, 2010.)

RPAC: The RPAC Committee of CCRA is responsible for distributing funds to elected officials in the Midlands throughout the year. The committee works to educate the membership on candidates and try to RPAC funds.

Technology: Stays on top of technology trends and helps educate & train membership on the benefits of using technology in their business.
